



## Vision Series Study 3: Mission



### **Read Acts 2:42-47**

1. As we saw last week, this passage describes God's new people loving one another like family: being together, eating together, sharing their stuff and generally loving & worshiping God by loving each other. What is the result?

### **Read John 13:34-35**

2. Jesus commands his followers to love one another in a particular way. What is it & what does the context tell us about what he means (see John 13:1-17)?
3. According to Jesus, when we love one another in this way what will it reveal to the world?

### **Read 1 Peter 2:9-12**

4. What does Peter urge God's new people to "put off" (verse 11) and "put on" (verse 12)?
5. Peter calls Christians "foreigners and exiles". Does this mean that we should live separately from the world?
6. What is Peter's ULTIMATE concern and what does this tell us about the goal of mission?

### **Read 1 Peter 3:13-15**

7. In the previous passage, Peter talked about the impact on a watching world of living good lives. In these verses he introduces another essential ingredient of mission. What is it and how is it related to living a good life?
8. Does this mean that we should wait to be asked before ever talking to unbelievers about Jesus?
9. What obstacles to mission are identified in this passage and what remedies are provided?
