3. In verse 5, what prompts Paul to give himself exclusively to preaching? What do you believe motivated this decision for him?

4. What is the consequence of his preaching?

5. What is the meaning behind Paul's symbolic action and his emotive comment in verse 6?

*"Your blood be on your own heads! I am innocent of it.
From now on I will go to the Gentiles."*

6. Is 'all lost' in the Greek town of Corinth? What are the signs of gospel growth?

7. What sort of impact can you imagine the message Paul receives in verse 9-10, had on his life and everyday ministry?
