Sunday	Give thanks to God he is at work growing his church to maturity.	Praise God for reconciling us to himself in Christ and giving us the ministry of reconciliation.	Give thanks that M is able to share life with women around her and be able to answer tough questions about God.
Monday	Praise our Father that he works in us creating a new self.	Ask God to make us godly ambassadors of Christ at home, at work, at sport, in the community and in fellowship.	Pray for people in the Middle East effected by Covid, pray that this season of fear will end.
Tuesday	Give thanks that in Christ we are members of one body.	Pray that unity-in-Christ at Mum & Me will be a witness to community mums and their children.	Give thanks that M and her flatmates were able to use time during Ramadan to memorize more stories and verses in Arabic.
Wednesday	Confess that in our anger we can sin.	Ask God for godly vision & wisdom for our Presbytery ministers as they meet together today.	Give thanks that M has been able to continue to meet and be encouraged by other Christians, Pray they can be bold for Christ.
Thursday	Ask that we might follow Christ's lead when someone sins against us.	Give thanks for the restoration and peace that comes through reconciliation.	Pray all can cling to the hope of Jesus through Covid lockdowns & restrictions.
Friday	Give thanks that our Father God is committed to binding us together in love.	Ask the Holy Spirit to help our Youth learn Christ's way of forgiveness.	Pray for those in the world who are suffering, ask that they can know our Heavenly Father as the one true comforter.
Saturday	Praise God that we can forgive, just as in Christ, he forgave us .	Ask the Holy Spirit to help parents teach Christ's way of forgiveness by example to their children.	Pray for Christians in Libya who face the daily threat of being abducted or killed by Islamic extremist groups.
