DEPART: LHS bus bay Saturday 8 July, arrive at 8:30 (bus leaves at 9).

RETURN: LHS bus bay Wednesday 12 July, approx. 1:30pm

WHAT TO BRING:

- Lunch for the first day
- Morning/afternoon tea foods to share
- Clothes (warm clothes, hat, PJs, and clothes suitable for activities)
- Closed-in shoes
- Toiletries
- Towel
- Sleeping gear (fitted sheet, pillow, sleeping bag)
- Bible & pen
- Water bottle
- Medication (contact Cameron for separate form and medication handed to leaders before departure)
- Torch for trips to the toilet (mainly at Old Bonalbo)

COVID / ILLNESS

We recommend administering a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) on your child/ren prior to departure. If your child tests positive, then please do not send them to Safari.

If your child displays Covid-19 symptoms on Safari we will contact you to seek your permission to administer a RAT. If they test positive, they will be isolated until you pick them up. If they test negative, we will work with you to make the right decision regarding medication or pick-up.

Saturday the 8th and Sunday the 9th will be spent at a site in Old Bonalbo which has no mobile service. If we need to contact you, or you need to contact us, then it will be via the landline at the site. The number for this landline is 66653261.

Also please be mindful that if your child does test positive for Covid-19 on Safari, or is so unwell that they need to go home, you must have a way of picking them up from Safari.
