PRAYER POINTS 14-20 April

SUNDAY - Praise God that because of Jesus we've been able to hear the good news of God's kingdom, and because the Holy Spirit has been poured out, we've been able to believe it.

MONDAY - Pray with Jotham and thank God for being patient with him when he makes mistakes, and that God is strong and sovereign in our weakness. Give thanks also for the refreshing breaks Jotham has enjoyed and for his recovery from sickness.

TUESDAY - Give thanks for Term 1 and pray that the school holidays may be a time of good rest and recreation. Help us not to forget Jesus when we're away from our regular routine and remind us that our relationship with him should never take a break.

WEDNESDAY - Confess that we can find it easy to forget that without Jesus we were/are dead in sin, and that only because of Jesus can we have a new heart, the Holy Spirit, forgiveness, love, peace and hope.

THURSDAY - Pray for protection of Christians whose stand for Jesus brings them daily the possibility (and often the reality) of violence and injustice. Ask that they would know God-inspired strength and courage. Also remember those who are imprisoned for their faith and pray that the Lord will sustain them and protect their families.

FRIDAY - Pray that we can love each other despite our differences - our church family and wider communities are full of people with different views and ideas, but despite whatever differences we have help us still strive to love them.

SATURDAY - Ask that God might humble us and remind us of our state before we knew Jesus and trusted in Him. Ask that He might help us to humbly live in thanks for all that he has done for us in Jesus!

PRAYER POINTS 21-27 April

SUNDAY - Thank God that his kingdom will one day be cleansed of all sin and evil.

MONDAY - Pray with Jotham and ask God to help him grow in wisdom to know how much work he can handle and to use Jotham's weak efforts of discipling people to establish them firmly in Christ.

TUESDAY - Pray that we might be building each other up in love and encouragement instead of dragging each other down. And that as we love each other the world might see the love of Jesus shining in our lives.

WEDNESDAY - Confess that as people of the kingdom, we can all too often look like the people of the world.

THURSDAY - Pray for protection for Christians in Chad. Ask God to strengthen them to withstand the many difficulties they endure (poverty, hunger, food insecurity, recovery from floods, discrimination and persecution to name a few).

FRIDAY - Pray that we might seek to love our Gospel Communities in creative and spontaneous ways and that together we might grow in love for God and those around us.

SATURDAY - Ask that we would long to look like our Sower, Jesus, the Son of Man.

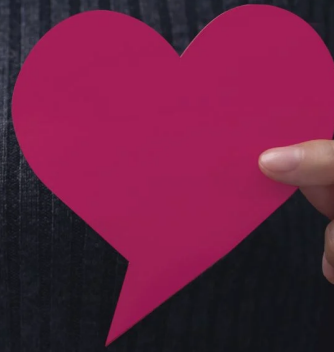

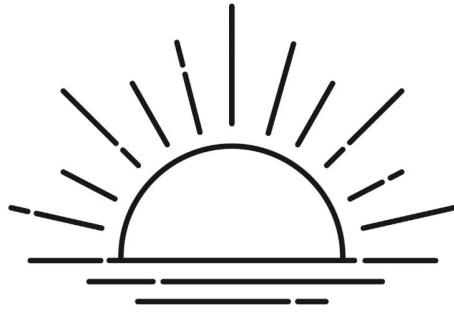
