CHANGES TO PARKING AT LISMORE HIGH



SCRIPTURE MEMORISATION

PRAYER POINTS

SUNDAY - Give thanks to God for the gift of motherhood and the loving sacrifice of mothers, both biological and spiritual, who nurture us and help us grow as followers of Jesus.

MONDAY - Thank God for his unending mercy. Praise God for the way he is so consistent and faithful in showing mercy.

TUESDAY - Give thanks for Pete Greenwood joining us at Equip tonight and for his desire to see the everyday reality of Jesus rule the challenges of life. Pray that we would be equipped to do this too and make sense of life through the lens of the gospel.

WEDNESDAY - Confess that when we're put under stress, we often take matters into our own hands rather than trusting in God's sovereign care.

THURSDAY - Confess that our own selfishness has caused pain and hurt for others.

FRIDAY - Pray for Christian women and girls who are marginalised, despised and persecuted because of their faith and gender. Ask that the Lord will be their protector and strength.

SATURDAY - Ask that God would enable us to put our hope in him, especially in times of stress and trial.
