


PRAYER POINTS

SUNDAY - Praise God for his endless grace and mercy to his people in the midst of our unbelief.

MONDAY - Praise God for the growth of the Iranian church and ask him to keep the Iranian believers joyful, bold and wise.

TUESDAY - Confess that we can live as those who do not trust in the promises of God, instead grasping at every good gift, including one another, to build an inferior kingdom, to that we have been promised in Jesus.

WEDNESDAY - Confess that we are so susceptible to doubting God at his word.

THURSDAY - Acknowledge the truth that only Jesus can satisfy our deepest longings and needs. Ask God to give us boldness to share this with our friends and

family and invite them along to Food for Thought and Hope Explored.

FRIDAY - Ask that the peace of Jesus and the righteousness He credits us, would overflow deeply into the lives of those we have been given and out of this peace we would sacrificially care for others.

SATURDAY - Ask that God would meet us in our unbelief, grant us daily repentance and help us to celebrate the wonder of our crucified saviour each day.
